What led to that change, and how did it impact your relationship with others and your ability to love people one at a time?
- 4. Read John 13:35 & John 5:39 Define the word "discipleship." Do you see it more as acquiring information or undergoing a life transformation? Why do you hold that perspective, and in what ways do you need Jesus to disciple you in loving people one at a time?
