The goal with this report is to share and celebrate all that GOD HAS DONE in 2023!

- Online Campus, The Village Live, reached an average of 534 people weekly! In addition, one of our social media reels from a Sunday message went viral with over 1,000,000 views and still counting.
- Seneca Campus celebrated their second birthday in February. In the fall, Seneca Pulse experienced amazing growth, reaching 45 students a week in grades 4 -8!
- Coal City Campus quickly grew in its first year, reaching an average of 178 people each week! The explosive growth may require adding a service or space in the future!
- Minooka Campus sent 70 people, adults and kids to launch the Coal City Campus in December 2022. Then God brought 150 new people to the Minooka Campus for continued growth in 2023!
- The Village had 79 baptisms! That's a new high, surpassing the previous record of 52 in 2022.
- We announced a potential Shorewood Campus launch for 2025! Stay tuned for details.

In this report, you will read many stories about lives changed by God! Please remember, these are all things GOD HAS DONE! Our goal in sharing and celebrating them is to give glory to God.



#### **LOCAL**

- 11 mobile food pantries (5 in Minooka, 4 in Seneca, 2 in Braidwood) provided 110,000 lbs. of food. 131 mobile food pantries have provided 1,310,000 lbs. of free food to our communities since 2005.
- Volunteers packed 3,950 food bags for the Channahon-Minooka Rotary Club Backpack Program. The food is discreetly placed in the backpacks of 150 kids from low income families.
- 155 guests attended the Dance The Night Away prom on May 5 for the special needs community.
- The Reclaimed golf outing and banquet was a success on June 26. The goal was to raise \$30,000 to put back in to the communities we serve. The result was \$39,500 raised.
- 439 kids came for new shoes and socks, laundry detergent, school supplies and clothes at the Big Give event on August 11 and 12.
- 70 turkey dinners were delivered to single moms and struggling families at Thanksgiving in the communities of Coal City, Seneca, and Minooka.
- \$17,000 was distributed in envelopes to equip our church family to be generous and make a difference in our world. This Little Light Of Mine (\$100) and One At A Time (\$20 \$50) envelopes were handed out to our church family to go out and make a difference in their communities.

#### **REGIONAL & GLOBAL**

- Our church family donated \$17,154 to Ms. Pearl's Christmas Store for the Good News Community Coffee House, a beacon of hope and connection point for the community of Roseland on the south side of Chicago.
- 289 Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes were filled and sent along with the good news about Jesus to children in countries around the world that have never heard about Him.
- The goal was to pack 100,000 meals for Haiti at the November 4 Lifeline Christian Mission Meal Pack. 450 volunteers packed 104,544 meals!




