Jesus Dies on the Cross

Bible Verse
Romans 10:9 "Believe in your heart that God
raised ahim from the dead."

Play 15 Minutes Greet kids and play time

Welcome, Connect, and Play

- 1. Welcome kids by name.
- 2. Ask kids what happened during their week and let them share their answers.
- 3. Ask about prayer requests and events kids told you about before.
- 4. Talk about welcome questions:
- What is the most fun toy at your house?
- If your friend wanted that fun toy, what would they have to give you for it?

Worship 2 Songs

Focus of the week: Every day, I am who Jesus says I am

Bible Story Video and Discussion Questions

- Who did God raise from the dead? Jesus
- What do you believe in your heart about Jesus?

Say: The point today is: Every day, I am who Jesus says I am. Let's say it and talk about it!

- Jesus says you're "righteous" when you choose to follow Him! What do you think "righteous" means? (Ideas: forgiven, Jesus takes away our sin, ready to do good, living for God, etc.)
- Everyone except Jesus sins. What do you think that means? (Ideas: everyone has made choices that hurt others, that disobey God, that are unloving or selfish, etc.)
- Jesus has all the righteousness. We have a lot of sin. Did Jesus say trade, or no trade? (Trade!)
- When do we get to have Jesus' righteousness?
 (When we believe in our heart that God raised Jesus from the dead and we choose to follow Him.)
- What do you think made Jesus want to trade His righteousness for our sin? (Ideas: He loves us, wants us to be God's friends, wants us to be forgiven, He wants to help us, etc.)

Game or Activity

Craft: Stained glass cross

What you need: Tissue paper, cross, contact paper.

What you do: Cut out the cross, lay it onto contact paper, and place tissue paper onto contact paper in the middle of the cross.

Game:

Say: In this game, you get to decide if you would trade with your friend, or not.

- 1. Explain what a trade is using the tips on the activity supplement.
- 2. Group all kids together in the middle of your small group space.
- 3. Read a potential trade from the activity supplement. 4. Kids who would make the trade move from the center of the group to your right side.
- 5. Kids who wouldn't make the trade move from the center of the group to your left side. 6. Repeat steps 2-5 as time allows.
