Read 1 Corinthians 12:4-11

- 1. God's Word reveals that our purpose is to serve God by serving others. Do you feel like you are fulfilling your God-given purpose for serving? Explain.
- 2. What are you naturally good at doing?
- 3. How can God be glorified through your talents, skills, or abilities?
- 4. Jesus said, "If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles" (Matthew 5:41). Explain a time where you have gone the extra mile for someone. What did it mean to him or her? What did it do for you?
- 5. Who is someone you know, whether an individual or a group, that is living out their God- given purpose?

Spend some time as a group discussing a way you can serve your community together. Set a date and make a plan for serving together as a group. Make it fun and enjoy serving!

Rank yourself on a scale of 1-10 (where 1 is "very poor" and 10 is "excellent") on how you are serving God right now. If comfortable, share that number with the group.
